Founder Tiffany deSousa is a former runaway, foster youth, & adopted youth who once relied on the very shelter CLCL now seeks to restore. She later returned as a counselor, & earned her Master of Arts in Child Advocacy & Policy to address the systemic gaps she experienced firsthand. Her leadership is rooted in resilience, reform, & relentless advocacy for youth in crisis.

Co-Founder Lisa Scala was the intake counselor the night Tiffany arrived at the shelter—a moment that marked the beginning of a lifelong mission. Lisa went on to serve at that shelter for 23 years, guiding countless youth through crisis with compassion & consistency. Today, she & Tiffany stand side by side as co-founders, restoring the space that once sheltered them both—one through service, the other through survival.

CLCL Foundation is determined to address the youth housing & mental health crisis through the restoration of Safe Haven access, with on-site mental & behavioral health services, family supports, respite, & reunification.

This is accomplished by prevention family & youth crisis, offering advanced services for those at-risk, & securing on-site facilities for those experiencing active crises.

Our homelessness & mental health crisis among juveniles & young adults is not a distant issue—it's unfolding in real time, in our own communities. Youth are languishing in hospitals, cleared for discharge but with nowhere safe to go. Shelters have shuttered. Beds are gone. The systems meant to protect them are buckling under the weight of inaction.
