Programs & Services

Community Care Connection (CCC) "Warm Line" Pilot Program

- Phase 1: Connections anyone in Ocean or Monmouth County to the closest donation site/resource for their needs
- Phase 2: On-site Donation Store for free clothing, accessories, & items
- Phase 3: Referral & delivery system to address & reduce poverty-based maltreatment allegations

Free Family Fun Night (FFFN)

- Monthly events for families provide opportunity to build shared positive memories & naturally build family resiliency
- Events usually 2 hours, with occasional special all day events
- Typically include entertainment, table of assorted available donations, & refreshments

Pending Programs

- Home Share Solutions Program (HSSSP) to address young adult (18-24) homelessness
- Tree House Emergency Youth Shelter to offer prevention & treatment of youth & family crises
