
Our Mission



We envision a community where every youth & young adult feels safe, supported, & included. Our goal is to prevent homelessness, trafficking, family crises, & child maltreatment, while empowering individuals to lead fulfilling lives & contribute positively to the community.

On January 28, 2025, during New Jersey's federally mandated Point-In-Time Count, 63 young adults ages 18 to 24 were identified as actively experiencing homelessness in Ocean & Monmouth Counties.

- Monmouth County, 6% were young adults aged 18 to 24.
- Ocean County, 4% were young adults aged 18 to 24

Local Homeowners at risk of foreclosure - helping to keep both landlord & tenant from homelessness.



Elderly Homeowners, the top users of Food Banks due to fixed incomes & rising prices.

- ▶ Program ready for ongoing evaluation with assistance from Dr. Waid, University of Minnesota School of Social Work
